The City of New Orleans' Office of Recovery and Development Administration (ORDA) is currently planning its 2010 program year, the fifth year of its 5-year Consolidated Plan (CP). The CP is the five-year Housing and Community Development Plan which is the planning and application process for four formula grants totaling approximately \$27.9 million:

The grants are the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) which includes the American Dream Downpayment Initiative (ADDI), Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG), and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS/HIV (HOPWA). The City must submit a 2010 Action Plan to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) which will detail how these federal funds are to be used to address Consolidated Plan priority needs. We are seeking your views on funding in areas such as housing, community/economic development, youth, senior citizens, homeless and other programs.

The City will hold a Public Hearing to discuss the 2010 Action Plan. The general public, as well as representatives from the business, housing, education, social service, non-profit, and faith-based communities are invited and encouraged to attend.
